The center's medical director, Stanley Cohan, M.D., Ph.D., was an investigator in the original, pivotal trial of beta interferon 1-A, one of the key medications for treating multiple sclerosis. He continues to play a leading role in MS research, and is the founder of the Pacific Northwest Multiple Sclerosis Registry Project, which receives grant funding from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

The goal of Providence Multiple Sclerosis Center is to provide persistent, assertive, focused treatment that minimizes the effects of MS on each patient's life. Patients benefit from comprehensive services that may include medication therapy, physical rehabilitation, counseling and other support services. In addition, they have access to the newest therapies through regional and international clinical trials.
